To apply for the Rosalyn Smith Scholarship, Jordan Family Scholarship, and the Beatrice Engram Scholarship, applicants must verify active participation in HAC- Delta Programs and have at least a 2.8 GPA. All other scholarships will be available to Delta Sigma Theta Sorority youth participants and students in the Greater Houston Area who meet the 3.0 GPA requirement. The Thelma Patton Law Scholarship is available to students with a major in medicine or science, who meet the 3.0 GPA requirement. Students applying for the 4 – year scholarship must maintain an overall 3.0 on a 4.0 GPA scale, inclusive of fall, spring and summer grades in order for the scholarship to be renewed.

To be considered, your completed application must contain:

- Letter of recommendation from **one school official** (include his or her title)
- Letter of recommendation from **one community leader not affiliated with your school** (pastor, club sponsor, volunteer organization director, etc.)
- **One attached photograph (wallet size) appropriate for Business Application**
- Letter of **acceptance from College/University**
- **Essay**
- **Copy of official transcript showing Rank, GPA, State Mandated Test Scores, SAT/ACT and the Registrars stamp, seal, and signature.** (May be sent directly from school to Delta P.O.Box)
- **GPA must be stated on transcript (2014 Copy)**

The scholarship awarded will be determined by the Scholarship and Awards Committee.

Applications must be postmarked by March 10, 2014. The scholarships will be reviewed March 22, 2014 and announced at the May Week Activities.

Scholarship applications will be made available to the Sorority at the January 2014 meeting and sent to HISD counselors in January 2014.

Scholarships will be awarded upon presentation of proof of enrollment in college, Fall 2014. Letters of recommendation must state and give examples of the positive characteristics and personal attributes of the applicant.

Write a brief essay (minimum of at least 300 words but not more than 500 words) telling of a significant experience, which has inspired you to pursue a college education. (typed/double spaced)
