W-2

This is a sample of the 2018 Form 1040 U.S. Individual Income Tax Return. The form is divided into several sections:

- Header:** Includes the year '1040' and the Department of the Treasury - Internal Revenue Service logo.
- Name, Address, and SSN:** Fields for the taxpayer's name, address, and Social Security Number.
- Filing Status:** Options for Single, Married filing jointly, Married filing separately, Head of household, and Qualifying widow(er).
- Exemptions:** Section for claiming dependents and other exemptions.
- Income:** A table listing various income sources such as wages, dividends, interest, and retirement income.
- Adjusted Gross Income:** A table showing deductions from gross income, such as educator expenses, state and local taxes, and mortgage interest.
- Footer:** Includes the form number 'Form 1040' and the year '2018'.

This is a sample of the 2020 Form W-2 Wage and Tax Statement. The form is used to report an employee's annual wages and taxes.

- Header:** Includes the year '2020' and the Department of the Treasury - Internal Revenue Service logo.
- Employer Information:** Fields for the employer's name, address, and ZIP code.
- Employee Information:** Fields for the employee's name, address, and Social Security Number.
- Wages and Taxes:** A table reporting wages, tips, and other compensation, along with federal, state, and local income taxes withheld.
- Footer:** Includes the form number 'Form W-2' and the year '2020'.
