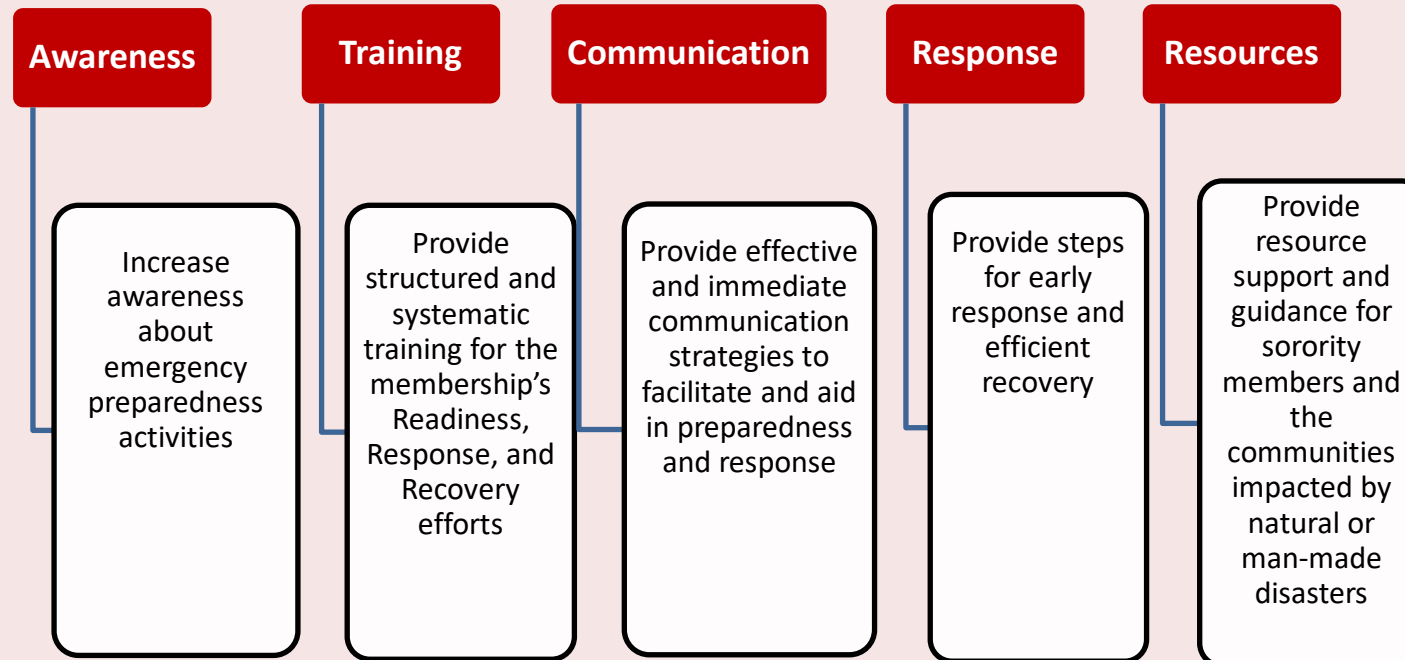

To assist chapters in achieving sound preparedness planning and practices by developing guidelines and references necessary to aid chapter members in their individual and collection preparation, in order to receive expeditious and swift restoration following a disaster.

Are You Ready? Recommended Disaster Supply Kit

Emergency Identification:

- Duplicate identification for all family members
- Duplicate prescription for medication and glasses
- Contact numbers of family members and meeting point location map
- Duplicate residency verification
- List of valuables for insurance claims

Basic emergency supply kit could include the following recommended items:

- *Water*: one gallon of water per person per day for at least three days, for drinking and sanitation
- *Food*: at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food
- *First aid kit and thermometer*
- Battery-powered or hand crank radio; NOAA Weather Radio w/ tone alert & extra batteries for both
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Whistle to signal for help
- Dust mask to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter in place
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities
- Manual can opener for food
- Mess kits, paper cups, plates, paper towels and plastic utensils
- Paper and Pencil
- Cell phone with chargers, inverter or solar charger
- Cash, travelers checks and rolls of change
- Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a waterproof, portable container.
- Change of clothes per family member (long sleeves, long pants, extra shoes)
- Sleeping bags or blankets and pillows
- Childs comfort kit: books, games, puzzles or other activities for children

Additional items may be:

- Infant formula and diapers
- Feminine supplies and personal hygiene items
- Pet food and extra water for your pet; Pet medical records and prescriptions
- Hearing-aid batteries
- Complete change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes
- Fire extinguisher
- Matches in a waterproof container. Candles.
- Extra eyeglasses and dentures

Family Activity:

1. Gather items for emergency kit
2. Discuss meeting point location if unable to return home
3. Provide information of meeting point contact to family members.
4. Identify an out-of-town contact as a designated person to call, text, or email

❖ **Overall Audit Findings**

- No material loss of financial assets exists and the Chapter has satisfactory internal controls.

Partnership Recommendation Planning

To ensure fairness, consistency and transparency we worked to provide a partnership opportunity for our fundraiser to maximize our fundraising efforts.

Additional 501©(3) partnerships were evaluated and considered, but as listed below, they did not meet our direct needs or unable due to timing of the fundraiser.

- Houston Area Urban League – conflict with event date and impacts their annual fundraiser event key to their operations.
- Delta Research Educational Foundation (DREF) – conflict with state tax regulations.
- One Delta Plaza Educational Center (ODPEC) – current filings, not reflected as such in IRS Database & GuideStar, potential impact to corporate sponsors, pending update on accounting process
- Chapter Members with 501©(3) – did not have time to establish a chapter approved process.

- Prepare a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) to clearly outline how funds will be managed, reported and reconciled between both parties.



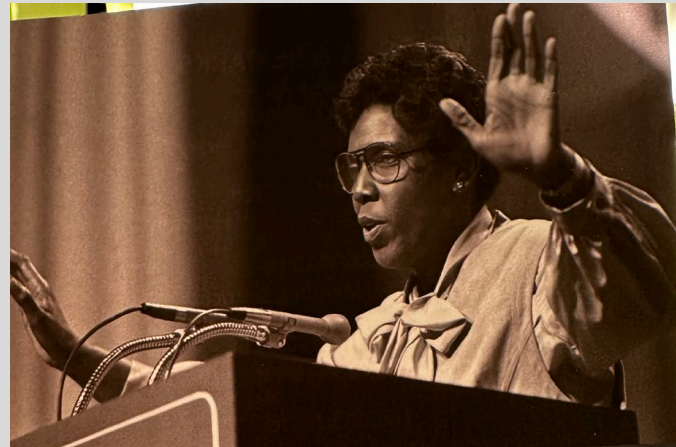

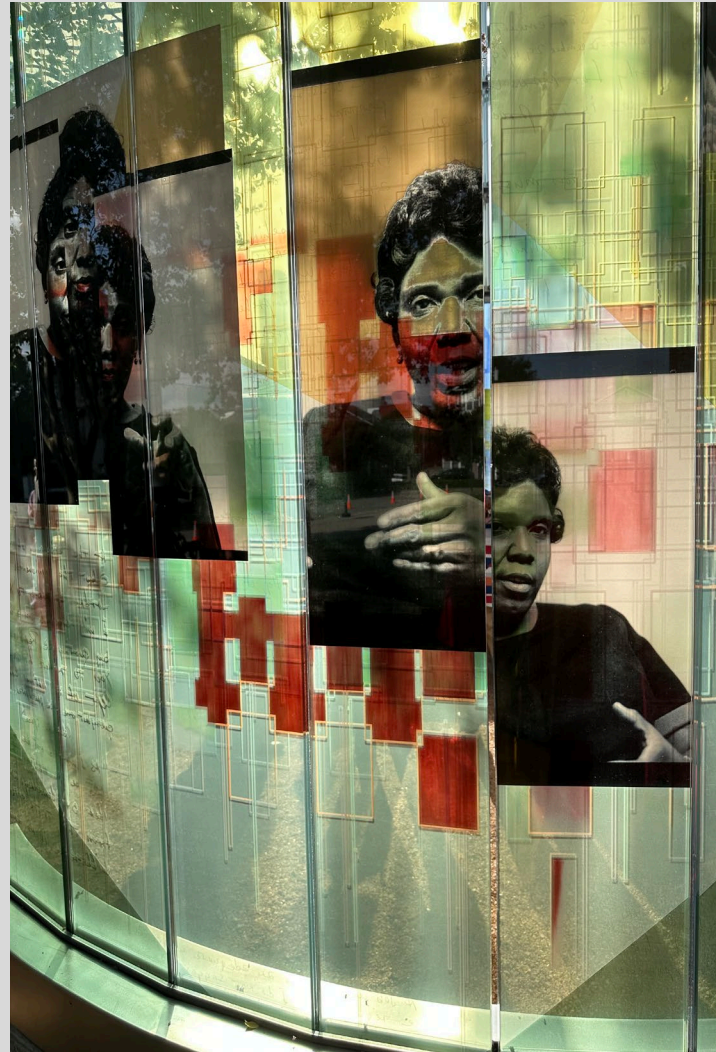

• Dear Superintendent Miles:

• My name is _____ and I am a proud member of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated. Our organization was founded in 1913 on the campus of Howard University in Washington, D.C. We are the largest Women's organization in the world and today our worldwide membership exceeds 350,000.

• Houston Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, of which I am a member, was chartered in 1927 and has a current membership of over 500 college-educated women. Since our chartering we have been active in the community with one of our priorities being "Educational Development."

• Recent reports indicate that as HISD Superintendent of Schools, you have developed a plan to eliminate librarians in the 28 schools that are under the New Education System (NES). The plan mentions repurposing the libraries at the 28 NES schools which are in communities attended by students from Black and Latino families with lower incomes. Access to a librarian with a wide-ranging selection of books can introduce students to life beyond their day-to-day and help them experience the world in a safe and nurturing environment.

• While I am happy that most HISD students will keep their librarians and use of the facilities as they were pre-NES, it is unjust that all HISD students will not have the same access. I implore you to support the learning needs of all HISD students and change your plans to keep our librarians in all HISD schools.

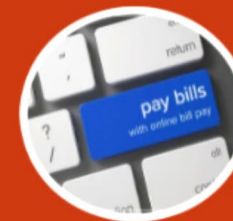

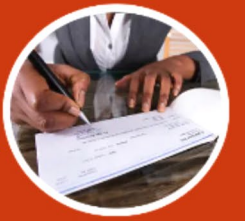
