SCHOLARSHIP TYPE: COLLEGE/VOCATIONAL/GRADUATE

Application Checklist

- Online Scholarship Application
- Two (2) Letters of Recommendation – on letterhead, signed, with title included
 - College professor, school official, or other staff member
 - Community Leader (e.g., Pastor, Volunteer Organization, Employer/Supervisor, etc.)
- Two (2) Essays: Minimum 250 words, no more than 450 words
 - Essay One: What motivates you to pursue your chosen career? If you have not yet chosen a career, what motivates you to pursue a college degree? Why do you deserve this scholarship?
 - Essay Two: Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. is an organization committed to public service. What contributions have you made to the betterment of your community through volunteer service? How has that impacted you?
